

消費券計劃 Consumption Voucher Scheme

\$5,000

Spending Together
Boosting the Economy

Electronic consumption vouchers with a total value of \$5,000 will be disbursed to each eligible person by instalments with a view to encouraging and boosting local consumption.

Eligibility criteria

Hong Kong permanent residents and new arrivals who are aged 18 or above on or before 18 June 2021 and residing in Hong Kong

Stored Value Facilities

Consumption vouchers will be disbursed through the four Stored Value Facilities: AlipayHK, Octopus, Tap & Go and WeChat Pay HK

Registration period

4 July to 14 August 2021

How to register

Electronic registrations

1. Visit www.consumptionvoucher.gov.hk or open iAM Smart mobile app
2. Authenticate your identity
3. Provide registration information and designate a Stored Value Facility account
4. Make declaration on the "residing in Hong Kong" requirement

Paper forms

1. Obtain a registration form from the following channels—
 - www.consumptionvoucher.gov.hk
 - Post offices (except mobile post offices)
 - Home Affairs Enquiry Centres of the Home Affairs Department
 - District Social Welfare Offices of the Social Welfare Department
 - Public Housing Estate Offices and the Hong Kong Housing Authority Customer Service Centre
2. Complete and sign the registration form and staple your Hong Kong Identity Card copy
3. Drop the form into the drop box at post offices or designated bank branches during office hours

Collecting the vouchers

AlipayHK, Tap & Go, WeChat Pay HK

- Direct injection into the SVF account through Mobile App

Octopus (by tapping the Octopus card)

- Subsidy Collection Points of PTSS at MTR stations, light rail customer service centres, designated public transport interchanges and ferry piers
- All outlets of 7-Eleven, Circle K and Wellcome supermarket (including Market Place, Market Place by Jasons, Jasons Ichiba and 3hreesixty)
- Octopus Service Points
- Octopus App

Using the vouchers

The consumption vouchers can be used at local retail, catering and service outlets or their online platforms. The following transaction items are **excluded**:

- Payments to the Government (e.g. tax, fines, licence fees, tunnel fees, parking meters)
- Payments to public utilities (i.e. water, electricity and gas)
- Payments to public organisations (e.g. Hospital Authority, Hong Kong Housing Authority, Hong Kong Housing Society)
- Education expenses (i.e. payments to primary and secondary schools providing local and non-local curriculum, and UGC-funded universities)
- Purchase of financial products or services (e.g. insurance)
- Donation (including charitable, religious and political organisations)
- Direct purchases from merchants located outside Hong Kong (including online purchases through non-local online platforms made locally)
- Person to person payments
- Encashment
