Part 4 Declaration and Undertaking of Registrant

1. I, the undersigned, declare that I am the holder of HKPIC/HKIC number as specified in Part 1 of this Form.
2. I have read and fully understand the content of the “Personal Information Collection Statement” in Part 5 of this Form.
3. I consent to the use of the Data for any checking and/or investigation relating to my registration (if any) and receipt of cash/non-cash handouts/refunds (if any) under Such Schemes to be carried out by the relevant bureaux and departments, including their agents and contractors, and that they may disclose the Data to any other parties if the disclosure is necessary for such checking and/or investigation or for ascertaining my eligibility related to Such Schemes.
4. I consent to the matching of the Data with my personal data held by the Government, including but not limited to my personal data kept under the Registration of Persons Ordinance (Cap 177) by the Immigration Department, in relation to my registration (if any) and receipt of cash/non-cash handouts/refunds (if any) under Such Schemes. I agree to promptly cooperate and provide all relevant documents and information for checking and/or investigating my compliance with the “residing in Hong Kong” requirement, including whether the reason(s) provided in Part 3 of this Form is/are genuine; and for other matters relating to my eligibility for Such Schemes, to be carried out by the relevant bureaux and departments, including their agents and contractors, and consent to the disclosure of all such relevant documents and information to any other parties if it is necessary to ascertain my eligibility for Such Schemes.
7. I agree and undertake to notify the Government forthwith of any overpayment or any payment or refund by mistake to me under Such Schemes and to repay or refund the same to the Government.

Part 5 Personal Information Collection Statement

How your Data will be used

Your information and personal data provided in this Form (including the copy of your HKPIC/HKIC attached to this Form), and other information that may be provided by you in relation to the Consumption Voucher Scheme (collectively referred to as the “Data”) will be used for the purpose of:

- (i) disbursing vouchers under the Consumption Voucher Scheme; and
- (ii) effecting cash/non-cash handouts/refunds (if any) under schemes administered by the Government in future that are aimed at, amongst other things, encouraging local consumption, relieving people’s financial burden, and/or returning wealth to the people (“Other Schemes”).

The purposes mentioned above are collectively referred to as “Purposes”; and the Consumption Voucher Scheme and Other Schemes are collectively referred to as “Such Schemes”.

The Data will be used:

- (i) to process your registration (if any) of and to administer the cash/non-cash handouts/refunds (if any) under Such Schemes (including but not limited to the process(es) referred to in (ii) to (iv) below);
- (ii) to communicate with you on matters relating to the Purposes, including but not limited to sending SMS notifications and effecting cash/non-cash handouts/refunds to you;
- (iii) to conduct matching between the Data and the personal data held by the Government to check your eligibility under Such Schemes;
- (iv) where applicable, to conduct checking and/or investigation on your compliance with the “residing in Hong Kong” requirement, including whether the reason(s) provided in Part 3 of this Form is/are genuine, and for other matters relating to your eligibility for Such Schemes;
- (v) as your updated data maintained by the Government for use under Other Schemes;
- (vi) for statistics purposes on the condition that the resulting statistics will not be made available in a form which will identify individual registrants (i.e. the data subjects); and
- (vii) for any other purposes as may be required, authorised or permitted by law.

It is voluntary for you to supply the Data. If you fail to do so, your registration (if any) under Such Schemes may not be processed or you may not receive the cash/non-cash handouts/refunds under Such Schemes.

Transfer and/or Disclosure of the Data

- (i) The Data will be transferred to and used by (a) relevant bureaux and departments of the Government including but not limited to the Treasury, Office of the Government Chief Information Officer, Immigration Department, Social Welfare Department and Financial Services and the Treasury Bureau (collectively referred to as the “relevant bureaux and departments”); (b) the SVF operator as selected by you in Part 2 of this Form; and (c) the agents and contractors respectively of (a) and (b), for the Purposes; and
- (ii) The Data will be disclosed to any other parties if such disclosure is necessary for the checking and/or investigation or to ascertain your eligibility related to Such Schemes, or agencies which are authorised to receive information relating to law enforcement, prosecution or review of the decisions regarding your eligibility under Such Schemes.

Data Access and Removal Requests

- (i) You have the right to request for access to and correction of the Data under the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Cap 486) (“the Ordinance”), subject to any relevant exemption(s);
- (ii) Please note that a data access request shall or may be refused in the circumstances specified in section 20 of the Ordinance;
- (iii) You have the right to request for not using the Data as your updated data maintained by the Government for use under Other Schemes; and

Guidance Notes

1. Eligibility Criteria

The registrant should fulfil the criteria below, i.e. the registrant -

- (a) is aged 18 or above on or before 18 June 2021; and
- (b) as at 18 June 2021,
 - (i) is a Hong Kong permanent resident holding a valid locally-issued HKPIC or Certificate of Exemption (“EC”); or
 - (ii) is a Hong Kong resident holding a valid HKIC or EC who has come to Hong Kong on Permit for Proceeding to Hong Kong and Macao (commonly known as “One Way Permit”); or
 - (iii) is a Hong Kong resident holding a valid HKIC or EC who has valid permission to remain in Hong Kong as a dependant sponsored by (b) (i) above; and
- (c) complies with the “residing in Hong Kong” requirement.

2. Registration

- (i) The registrant should provide his/her signature in this Form and a copy of his/her HKPIC/HKIC. Failure to provide the required information, document and the signature of the registrant may result in non-processing of this Form. Please provide an SMS-enabled local mobile phone number to facilitate the Consumption Voucher Scheme Secretariat (“Secretariat”) or its agents and contractors to communicate with you on matters related to your registration. Failure to provide any local contact phone number may delay or even hinder the processing of your registration and disbursement of vouchers (if any).
- (ii) Registrants may also register on-line via the website of the Scheme.
- (iii) Each registrant should select only **ONE** SVF and each SVF account can only be registered **ONCE** under the Scheme. Change of SVF and/or SVF account after the submission of this Form will not be allowed save with the request/approval of the Secretariat.
- (iv) The registrant has to declare in relation to his/her compliance with the “residing in Hong Kong” requirement as set out in paragraph 1(c) above.
- (v) Each registrant should submit only **ONE** registration under the Scheme (i.e. **ONE** registration **either** in paper form **or** online) and ensure accuracy of the information provided. Duplicate registrations will not be processed. This Form, once submitted, cannot be withdrawn except with valid reasons. Subsequent amendment of information therein will delay the processing of registration and disbursement of vouchers (if any).
- (vi) The duly completed and signed Form, together with a copy of the HKPIC/HKIC should be submitted **during office hours** between 4 July and 14 August 2021 through the designated drop-box placed at any post offices or designated branches of Bank of China (Hong Kong), Bank of East Asia, Hang Seng Bank, The Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation, and Standard Chartered Bank (Hong Kong). The addresses of the post offices and designated bank branches are available on the website of the Scheme.
- (vii) The Secretariat and the relevant bureaux and departments, including their agents and contractors, may contact the registrant in respect of the information provided in this Form including conducting checking and/or investigation on his/her compliance with the “residing in Hong Kong” requirement, including whether the reason(s) provided in Part 3 of this Form is/are genuine, and other matters relating to the registrant’s eligibility for the Scheme. Where necessary, e.g. in the event of inaccurate or incomplete information, the registrant may be requested to make a re-submission. Registrants with their eligibility confirmed will receive disbursements of vouchers through their selected SVF account. The vouchers can only be used for consumption covered by the Scheme. The coverage of consumption vouchers under the Scheme is published on the website of the Scheme. In case the registration is not successful, the Secretariat will send a notification by SMS to the registrant according to the contact telephone no. provided in this Form.
